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Park Air Signs Contract for Korean Supply

The equipment supplied will be part of the Sapphire portfolio of products, centred on the T6 Radio. This will supply South Korean airspace with one of the most advanced radios on the market today. Equipment will also be provided for a simulator site, which is used for on-going hands-on training.
